Re: CT PTSA Help & Save Discount Power Program – Participation Agreement

Our Unit's Officers are fully aware of the program and understand and agree to the following:

1. The CT PTSA is a contracted Sub-Broker with Discount Power, Inc. (DPI) a DPUC licensed electric generation supplier based in Shelton, CT who is making this program available to the CT PTSA.
2. As Sub-Broker, the CT PTSA earns a commission for all kilowatts enrolled in the program and is sharing that commission with each individual unit as an additional revenue source for participating units.
3. Our unit's officers are fully aware of all the program details that have been provided. Our unit will make a concerted effort to inform our members and encourage them to enroll in the program. We also understand that the program is not limited to members only and will encourage members to inform friends, neighbors, local businesses, etc. The more kilowatts enrolled, the greater the earnings will be to our unit.
4. We are familiar with the commission structure (see Example below) and that our unit will earn \$0.005 per kilowatt enrolled in the program. The commission is paid on a monthly basis via Electronic Fund Transfer.
5. Attached are the completed Direct Deposit Authorization and a W-9 Forms required for participation in the program and for commissions to be paid to your unit.
6. To track enrollments and commissions, each unit will be assigned an individual Discount Code. We understand that the Discount Code must be entered at the time of enrollment so accounts can be tracked to our unit. Further, if the Discount Code is not entered, we understand that the commission will be paid to the CT PTSA.
7. We understand that the CT PTSA is the contracted Sub-Broker and our unit specifically is not under any contract with DPI. To that end, our unit will not make any representations.
