## ADMENDMENT 1

ARTICLE VII: OFFICERS
Section 1. The Officers of Connecticut PTA, who serve on the Board of Directors and, as a group, constitute the Executive Committee, shall be the:
a. President;
b. President-Elect or First Vice President;
c. Secretary-Treasurer;
d. Three Four Vice Presidents

Rational: Adding a VP Position.

## ADMENDMENT 2

ARTICLE VII: OFFICERS
Section 5. The Vice Presidents shall be:

- Membership,
- Government Relations, Advocacy
- and_Inclusivity/Outreach
- Development.
a. Coordinate their designated areas of responsibility as defined in the Procedures;
b. Upon request of the President or pro tem President (the President-Elect/First Vice President), or by majority vote of the Executive Committee, when necessitated by the President and pro tem President both being absent or unable to serve, perform the duties of the President in the order of precedence listed above.

Rational: To bring value to the VP roles by designating areas of importance to CT PTA.

## ADMENDMENT 3

ARTICLE X: BOARD OF DIRECTORS
Section 2. The members of the Board of Directors are:
a. All elected Officers;
b. The Immediate Past President, which is the President who last completed a term prior to the term of the current President; non-voting.
c. All presidents of Councils; 1 Council President , 1 at large Unit President
d. The Nominating Committee Chair;
e. Five (5) members-at-large;

Director of Marketing/Communications
Director of Technology/digital
Director of Events/support Coordinator
f. Two (2) Education representatives;

Rational: Re-establishing roles and responsibilities will make for a more productive BOD
There will be an advisory council which will be defined in the $P$ and $P$. Details to follow.
